WHAT IS THE HÆDLINKS PROGRAM?

The Hædlinks Program is an international training experience designed for people who wish to enhance their knowledge and skills in three key areas of global development: sustainable entrepreneurship, international diplomacy and building strategic alliances.

Powered by The FuturED Institute and supported by the International Green Trade & Commerce Association (IGTCA), this programme combines theory, practice and networking in an immersive and multicultural environment across Edinburgh and Glasgow (Scotland), leading centres of governance, innovation and institutional leadership.

Over five days, participants will have access to intensive workshops, institutional visits, professional development sessions and direct interaction with industry experts and leaders, in an experience that promotes transformational leadership and strategic thinking.

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

This programme delivers an immersive learning experience centred on creative intelligence, strategic foresight, and innovation-driven transformation. It equips participants to navigate complexity, uncertainty, and rapid change by strengthening creative judgement, systemic thinking, and strategic decisionmaking across organisational and societal contexts.

Participants in the “CREATIVE INTELLIGENCE FOR STRATEGIC TRANSFORMATION” (CISTX) will work towards the following outcomes:

- Creative intelligence and strategic context.
- Systems thinking and innovation judgement.
- Navigating governance and institutional frameworks.
- Integrating creativity, policy, and strategic foresight.
- Executive leadership and collaborative practice.

METHODOLOGY

The programme adopts an executive, practice-oriented methodology designed to translate creative intelligence, systems thinking, and strategic leadership into actionable insight. Learning is structured around applied analysis, institutional case exploration, and expert engagement, enabling participants to connect conceptual frameworks with real-world governance, innovation, and transformation challenges.

Participants engage in expert-led briefings, moderated strategic dialogues, and scenario-based exercises focused on institutional decision-making, governance models, innovation ecosystems, and sustainable transformation. The methodology emphasises comparative perspectives, strategic foresight, and cross-sector analysis, encouraging participants to assess challenges from public, academic, and organisational viewpoints.

The programme is highly interactive, fostering peer exchange, collaborative problem-solving, and direct dialogue with senior practitioners and institutional leaders. This approach strengthens creative judgement, leadership capability, and strategic adaptability in complex and evolving environments.

All sessions are conducted in English, ensuring accessibility for an international executive audience.


